Scheme of Delegation

Executive Summary and Recommendations

Introduction

The scheme of delegation is intended to facilitate the efficient and effective functioning of the Health Professions Council.

The scheme is designed to ensure that, so far as possible, the Council and its Committees set policy and strategy and that the Executive implements that policy and strategy and is responsible for all operational matters.

The Scheme sets out:

- those decisions which the Council has reserved to itself;
- those decisions which it has delegated to its Education and Training Committee
- those decisions which it has delegated to the Chief Executive and Registrar, some of which may also be exercised by nominated officers of the Executive or by persons nominated by the Chief Executive;
- those decisions which it has delegated to other nominated officers of the Executive.

The Executive, under the direction of the Chief Executive, remains responsible for day to day administration of the Council's affairs and nothing in the Scheme applies to any decision which is administrative in nature.
