## **Executive Summary and Recommendations**

## Introduction

On 12<sup>th</sup> March the Department of Health published a consultation document on the proposals for the Health Professions Council (HPC) to statutorily regulate applied psychologists.

This followed the recommendation by HPC to the Secretary of State for Health on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2004 that the profession should be regulated.

The consultation raised eight specific questions and the HPC's draft responses are attached.

### Decision

The Council is requested to approve the response.

HPC's departmental workloads will increase, particularly Fitness to Practise, Education and Policy, UK and International/Grandparenting Registration.
