The IMPT holds scientific meetings and conferences and organises formal training courses and seminars that are able to be used as CPD. In May 2001, voluntary CPD for all IMPT members was introduced. In 2003, mandatory CPD was voted upon and was introduced in January 2004. The profession has determined a minimum level of CPD to be undertaken (20 points over a 4 year period). The points allocated to an activity are determined by the Professional Development Officer. The profession employs a Professional Development Officer, who is responsible for CPD, on a voluntary, part-time basis. Non compliance with CPD as outlined in the fitness to practice document is subject to disciplinary procedure.
