The training was in four parts – Tax Transparency, Financial Reporting Update, Governance Update and ABC (Anti-Bribery and Corruption) and Fraud Update. There was a healthy amount of participant involvement in all sessions.

The Tax Transparency session was most interesting. Whilst not obviously of significant impact for HCPC, the disclosure of taxes paid is important and this year we have shown the irrecoverable VAT included in expenses.

Financial Reporting Update - We started on the FRC's 2015/16 priority areas and key judgements, moved on to IFRS 15 and then an update on leasing. Highly technical and not for the fainthearted.

Governance - This was really good. We covered risk, control and longer-term viability, then on to FRC's key issues and future work.

ABC & fraud – excellent.
