1	<p><b>Item 7. Forward planning session feedback</b></p> <p>The Committee discussed holding a workshop of the approach to panel performance and feedback monitoring methods. Fitness to Practise Final Hearing Decisions Audit (report ref: TAC 28/19)</b></p> <p>The Committee noted the positive outcomes of the study but expressed concern at the delay in publication of the results, noting that the Decisions were reviewed in January 2019, and the audit report was dated as such.
